ORDER SCHOOL PICTURES NOW: If you haven't already, go to midwest.orderschoolpix.com to view your child's school picture. Your School ID (which will be your child's password on the website) was sent home. If you need that ID # again, contact the office. Orders will be delivered to school 2 weeks after the close of the gallery (should close October 19th). The gallery will start over with retakes, **which will be Wednesday, October 20th from 9-9:30 AM. Please notify the office if you want retakes so we don't miss your child.**
