We will be working with GAP (Grace & Peace) Ministries, which is a local ministry run by Pastor Michael & Janis Carmody of NCCC. They have already dug 13 wells in India, and we are so blessed to be able to join with them in digging another. The cost of the well is \$1400. This fundraiser will run the rest of the school year unless we raise the money before then. The CCS students will work in their classrooms to do extra fun activities to raise the money needed for the well. This is NOT required, but we appreciate any monetary donations that students bring.

Each class has 'adopted' two of these children and have specific information regarding clothing sizes and toys that these children may like.
