FOR TRANSPORTATION OF NON-PUBLIC STUDENTS



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- (1) Students must reside within the boundaries of the **Fort Dodge Community School District**.
- (2) Students must reside **two (2) miles** or greater from their center of attendance. Distance will be measured from a point in the Public roadway opposite the student's residence to a point in the public roadway opposite the entrance to the school grounds.
- (3) Reimbursement will be provided only for students enrolled in a program accredited by the Iowa Department of Education.
- (4) Reimbursement will be prorated on the basis of the number of days the student was enrolled in an accredited program during the semester.
- (5) Families transporting one or more family members more than four (4) miles to the designated non-public school of attendance will be provided with a supplemental payment to be calculated by the Department of Education.

The district claiming process and payment process will now be a **once-a-year** process rather than a semester process. Parents are required to continue to fill out a claim form for each semester. Nonpublic parents must notify their resident public school district by filing a parent reimbursement request along with specified information, in writing, no later than December 1, for the first semester and May 1, for the second semester. Nonpublic parents failing to notify the district by the established deadlines will be considered not eligible for reimbursement for the claim period and will not be included with the districts claim. The District will issue the reimbursement parental payments for both semesters, no later than the second regular bill run following the July receipt of funds from the department of education.
